- ◆ Audience is researchers, practitioners and educators

 - Descriptions of innovative programs
 - Theory development

JAH Features Commentary

◆ Types of articles

- Manuscripts that present a scholarly discussion of an issue in allied health
- Application of theory to practice
- Recommendation for change
- Critiques of practice

JAH Features

Research Notes

◆ Types of articles

- Brief (5-6 pages) reports of research studies
- Small scale or pilot research
- Must be methodologically sound

JAH Features

Methodologists Corner

◆ Types of articles

- Introduction of methodological approaches**
- New statistical procedures**
- Debates related to methodological issues**
- Discussions about other research issues**

JAH Features

Contemporary Issues

- ◆ Types of articles
 - Summaries of major reports
 - Keynote speeches
 - Conference proceedings
 - Outcomes of important meetings

Potential Patterns

◆ Types of articles

- Descriptions of ongoing projects which are innovative and change-oriented
- Usually relate to more than one field
- Published in Journal Supplement


JAH Features

Allied Abstracts

- ◆ **Abstracts of key articles from other journals that deal with current thinking in allied health education and practice**
 - ◆ **May be from any professional journal, whether or not in allied health**
 - ◆ **Published in Journal Supplement**

Book Reviews

- ◆ **Reviews of books, monographs or audiovisual materials**
 - ◆ **Critical analysis**
 - ◆ **Published in Journal Supplement**
